

## Title I Supplemental Educational Services

### Compass Classical Academy

Federal grants are awarded to school districts with a high number of children from low income families. These funds are used to provide services to targeted students to ensure all students gain academic skills to meet state-level academic proficiency standards. Specifically, funds are used to provide qualified teachers and materials necessary to meet these goals.

At Compass Classical Academy, students are targeted based on their level of risk to meet these standards. This is determined by the individual student's performance on standardized and curriculum-based assessments, along with teacher recommendations. Funds are used to provide in-school math and reading support. This is accomplished during times that do not interfere with direct instruction in the classroom. Intervention may include an extended day and/or summer program. Intervention will support the classroom instruction rather than replace it. Classroom teachers and Title I staff communicate regularly to assure coordination.

Parent involvement is an integral part of the Title I program. A variety of opportunities will be provided to learn more about the Title I program, be a part of the planning process, participate in their child's education, and be informed of their child's progress. Parents participate in determining the program plan and how they are involved.
